### D8.5 MEDEA 3rd Project Review Report

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### Abstract

This deliverable is the M13-M18 Project review report, which details the progress made by the MEDEA consortium in three aspects. First, the report outlines the progress made in “monitor research and innovation projects with a view to recommending the uptake or the industrialisation of results”. Secondly the document “express common requirements as regards innovations that could fill in capability and other gaps and improve their performance in the future”. Thirdly, D8.5 “indicates priorities as regards common capabilities, or interfaces among capabilities, requiring more standardization”. D8.5 reports the last six months of progress in MEDEA and it complements D8.4 and D8.13.

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## Executive summary

D8.5 is the third MEDEA project review report. The first version of the report (D8.4) reported both the project and network related activities occurred during the first six months of the project. The second version of the report (D8.13) documented only the network related activities performed between M6 (November 2018) and M12 (May 2019). The third version of the report, documents the network related activities performed between M13 (June 2019) and M18 (November 2019).

MEDEA is a consortium which is developing and evolving a multidiscipline practitioners' network. The report details the activities performed for the identification of research and innovation actions that would be of interest to network members.

During the first six months, the project identified a series of innovative actions. The MEDEA members expressed their will to monitor their progress with regards to these actions, as well as several threats that MEDEA members preferred to interact with.

The second version of MEDEA project review report documented the progress made in these two directions. In addition, the previous version of the report documented additional innovative actions (other networks and projects) that MEDEA network practitioners would benefit by interacting with. If possible, joint events and actions (with members from other research actions) to explore opportunities and build synergies were identified.

The third version of the Project Review Report documents new projects and innovative actions MEDEA members would like to monitor. Additionally, this report presents the results from a number of joint activities performed with other networks and projects.
