The MEDEA consortium will set up and coordinate the Data Privacy, Ethics and Legal matters Committee (DELIC) of the project, as detailed in Task 8.1 in the Description of Action. DELIC members will be academics and renowned professionals (at national and EU level), specialised in data privacy issues, ethical mandates and legal directives related to security research. Thus the need of data privacy and protection of personal data is acknowledged. Furthermore, the assigned DPOs of project members that might be involved with the collection/processing of personal data will ensure MEDEA adherence to EU legislation for Data Protection.
